DAIRY SHOW**

Tuesday, July 27 at 10 a.m. with Goats

Immediately following the goat show the dairy cattle show will begin. Entry fee must be paid in each Livestock Department. Entries must be paid in advance by Sunday, July 25 at 9 a.m. at fair office. Entry fee is \$4.00 first animal, 50 cents each additional head.

1. Ages are computed from March 1 and September 1. (Example: junior calf born after March 1, 2009. No calves born after May 1, 2009 can be shown. Detailed ages are indicated in the 4-H Dairy Section.)
2. Senior competition will include animals born prior to September 1, 2007.
3. All cattle are to remain at the fair until 10 p.m. on Saturday.
4. 4-H and FFA animals cannot be shown on another exhibitor's entry.
5. Registration papers or grade identification papers which includes breed association provisional grade identification system of the D.H.I.A.'s V.I.P. grade identification program, must be available to be checked by the superintendent on the arrival of animals at the fair grounds.
6. 4-H and FFA members can show grade animals in Open Class up to senior yearling that have been identified through the Extension Office identification from which have been verified by a 4-H leader or Vo-Ag instructor two years and older, refer to Rule 5.
7. Entries in each department are to be listed on separate sheets with complete address and zip code.
8. A per head fee of \$2.00 to cover stall space is required. All entries and all stall rental fees must be paid in advance to qualify for exhibiting.
9. Dairy Exhibits open to Huron County Residents Only.
10. Each exhibitor will be limited to 2 animals in one class.
