SHOW DATE

Tuesday, July 27 & Wednesday, July 28

(All sections have the same classes and premiums.)

1. All parties making entries in this department will be charged at the rate of \$5.00 per tie stall, \$10.00 per box stall, and an entry fee of \$7.00. This must be paid by 9 p.m. Sunday, July 25 at the fair office along with entry forms and class cards. No exhibitor fee or stall rent will be refunded.
2. All horses to arrive between noon and 8 p.m. on Sunday, July 25.
3. **Horses trailered in the day of show must pay \$5.00 entry fee per class to be paid on show day.**
4. Entries are **limited to two animals** per exhibitor in any one class.
5. Ages of animals and riders shall be computed from January 1, 2009.
6. Exhibitors must present certificate of registry on horse or pony entered in registered class to fair office before showing.
7. In such case party fails to show his animal when same shall be called for no premium will be paid.
8. No premium will be awarded when the animal is not worthy, even though there is no competition.
9. All animals must remain in their stalls at all times except during judging, exercise and wash times which shall be posted by fair management.
10. **Animals must be led to and from wash and exercise areas at all times and ridden only in the arenas.**
11. Horses will be released Wednesday at 10 p.m. You must be out by 8 a.m. Thursday.
12. Infractions of these and other barn rules directed by the superintendent in charge may result in dismissal of exhibitor and animal from the fair grounds with all premiums being forfeited.
13. Horses that are double registered can only be shown under one section.
14. Proper attire and exhibitor number must be worn at all times.
15. **Enter at your own risk, all owners should have general liability insurance. The fair assumes no liability.**
16. No horses are to be unloaded in the south parking lot.
17. We encourage decorating stalls. You are required to remove all material used for decorating. If decorations are not removed to the satisfaction of the fair management, premiums will be withheld.
18. Youth under 8 years of age as of 12/31 of fair year cannot show livestock as individual. Must have parent or guardian in ring.
