

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**  
**SECTION I – GENERAL**

1. The gates shall be open at 8 a.m. of each day at which time every officer and employee shall be at his or her post of duty.
2. The Board of Directors reserves the final and absolute right to interpret these rules and regulations and to arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions of differences in regard thereto. It further reserves the right to amend or add to these rules and in case these receipts of the Fair are insufficient to pay premiums and expenses, the Association may pay pro ratastrums on all premiums awarded.
3. Disregard of any rule by an exhibitor or concessionaire forfeits all premiums, rights, and privileges without recourse.
4. In the event of conflict between the general rules and special rules governing various departments, the special rules will take precedence.
5. Each division of the Fair will be in charge of one or more Superintendents, who, with such assistant or clerk as may be needed, will have the management of such department, as directed by the Board of Directors or manager. Such Superintendents of all departments exhibiting for competition will report at the Secretary's office at 9 a.m. on the second day of the Fair, where they will be furnished with judge sheets in the several departments and receive such instructions as may be necessary. These sheets must be returned to the secretary, with the findings o f the judges properly recorded thereon, as soon as premiums are awarded.
6. 6. Any false representation, interference, or ungentlemanly conduct on the part of an exhibitor, merchant or individual will be dealt with by the Board of Directors according to the merits of the case.
7. The Fair Association, Board of Directors and Superintendents will not be responsible for the behavior of any exhibitor, merchant or individual, whether he or she be adult or minor.
