Educational Poster Procedure

- 1. Only 1 poster entry per participant, per specie, entered by age division:
 - a. Senior 16 year olds and over.
 - b. Intermediate Division 13-15 year olds.
 - c. Junior Division 11-12 year olds.
 - d. Beginner 9 and 10 year olds.
 - e. Beginner Cloverbuds 6-8 year olds.
 - *Cash prizes will be awarded to 1st and 2nd place winners in each age division and specie.
- 2. Educational poster must be the work of the youth participant and created within the last 12 months.
- 3. Poster subject/theme should directly relate to the following topics:

- 4. Posters will be judged on how well they present information, their general appearance, and their importance
- 5. Poster size may not exceed 22" by 28"
- 6. Poster must be made of poster or tag board or other light bases. 3-dimensional posters will not be allowed.
- 7. The back of posters must include the following information:
 - a. Name
 - b. Age Division
 - c. Resource list

8. All posters will be displayed in the SLA barn by the superintendents. Posters must be in the SLA Barn by 12noon, Tuesday of Fair week and will be displayed until 10pm, Saturday. Participants can pick up posters after this time. Cash prizes will be awarded with fair checks.
