

# SLA Educational Exhibit Guidelines

## Educational Poster

1. Only 1 poster entry per participant, per specie, entered by age division:

- a. Senior - 16 years old and over.
- b. Intermediate Division - 13-15 year olds.
- c. Junior Division - 11-12 year olds.
- d. Beginner - 9 and 10 year olds.
- e. Beginner Cloverbuds – 6-8 year olds.

\*Prizes will be awarded to 1st and 2nd place winners in each age division and species.

2. Educational posters must be the work of the youth participant and created within the last 12 months.

3. Poster subject/theme should directly relate to the following topics:

Senior	Marketing your animal / Profitability of your market project (compare fair project to industry)	Internal organs: identification, parts, and functions	Advanced topic not already listed
Intermediate	How to select a market animal/judging	Comparing mono-gastric, ruminant, and poultry digestive systems.	Nutrition/Understanding a feed label/feed label comparison
Junior	Reproduction and breeding of specie	Common diseases symptoms/effects/ID/ treatment	Housing Requirements
Beginner	How to be a good showman	Breed ID/characteristics/origin/ use of at least 5 breeds	How to prepare your animal and yourself for show Introduce me to your animal
Beginner Cloverbud	How to take care of your animal	Introduce your animal	Parts of your animal

4. Posters will be judged on how well they present information, their general appearance, and their importance. Poster size may not exceed **22" by 28"**. Poster must be made of poster or tag board or other light bases. 3-dimensional posters will not be allowed.

5. The back of posters must include the following information:

- a. Exhibitor Name
- b. Age Division
- c. Resource list

6. All posters will be displayed in the SLA barn by the superintendents. Posters must be in the SLA Barn by **6pm, the first Sunday of Fair week** and will be displayed until 7pm, Saturday. Participants **MUST** pick up posters by 9pm on the Saturday of fair.
